

TRIANGLE SALES IMPORTANT SALE FACTS

Thank you for your entry into the 2019 Triangle Fall Sale. Please carefully review the following sale rules and procedures. If you have any questions, contact us at (405) 275-2196.

THE SALE OFFICE WILL OPEN AT 8:00 AM DAILY, THURSDAY, OCTOBER 24, THROUGH SATURDAY, OCTOBER 26. CHECK-IN AT THE SALE OFFICE WHEN YOU ARRIVE.

1 STALLING

Stalls will be available Thursday, October 24, at 8:00 am. If you need to arrive earlier, please contact the sale office for arrangements. Please check-in at the sale office upon arrival for your stall assignments and hip numbers. Additional bedding may be purchased through the sale office. No straw or hay bedding is allowed by the Expo Center. Bring your own buckets, feed and hay.

2 NO HORSES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SALE GROUNDS UNLESS ENTERED IN THE SALE.

3 CATALOG PAGE ACCURACY

The entire catalog is posted on our website at www.trihorse.com. You will also be mailed a catalog to the current address we have on file for you. PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE SALE OFFICE OF ANY CORRECTIONS PRIOR TO THE SALE. YOU ARE THE SOLE GUARANTOR OF ALL CATALOG INFORMATION.

4 SALE HIP ORDER

Hip order for each sale session was determined by alphabetical order using the first letter of the second dam's name. A draw was made to determine the beginning letter. Grade horses were numbered by substituting their names for the second dam's name. When multiple horses with the same dam/second dam were drawn back to back, owners may have requested they be moved forward or backward approximately ten horses in the daily order.

5 ORIGINAL REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS

Unless you have already forwarded these to the sale office, they are due **NOW**, and before your horse can sell.

- a. Original Registration Certificate
- b. Completed Transfer (authorized signatures must be on file at AQHA)
- c. Original Breeders Certificate (For Pregnant Broodmares/Embryos)

We will withhold any funds due until all such documents are delivered.

Additionally, you must notify us of any necessary changes to original registration certificates regarding color, markings, brands, sex, etc.

6 ORIGINAL NEGATIVE COGGINS & HEALTH CERTIFICATE – HORSES CANNOT GO THROUGH SALE RING WITHOUT THESE

- a. Original Negative Coggins **DATED WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF SALE**
COPIES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE NOR ARE TEST RESULTS PRINTED ON A HEALTH CERTIFICATE.
- b. Original Health Certificate dated within twenty (20) days of sale

7 STATUS FOR PREGNANT MARES/RECIPIENTS

A veterinary certificate of "pregnancy" or "open" status, dated within twenty (20) days prior to the sale, must be submitted and on file in the sale office. The status may be noted on the Health Certificate or presented as an additional veterinary document.

8 ENGAGEMENTS/ELIGIBILITIES

Any special event eligibilities (not already listed in the sale catalog) should be indicated in writing at check-in for announcement during sale.

9 DEMONSTRATIONS

Cutters/Cow Horses - \$70 For Live Cattle While Selling on Fri., October 25

A custom track cow will be available in the sale ring for use during the sale on both days.

An additional track cow will be available in the make-up pen both days.

Barrel Horses – Barrel Preview on Fri., October 25, at 4:00 pm

Roping Horses - \$50 For Roping Demonstration (maximum 5 runs per horse) on Sat., October 26, at 8:00 am

A “Smart Steer” and a “Perfect Calf” will be available during the day for use in the practice pen Friday and Saturday.

10 SALE DAY RESPONSIBILITY

It is your responsibility to get your horse to and from the auction arena. Handlers are available to lead your horse if needed.

11 ALL PRIVATE SALES – ESPECIALLY THOSE COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS “ALLEY SALES” ARE NOT PERMITTED

No horse may be sold privately before it is offered publicly. If a horse is “repurchased” or “passed-out” in the auction arena, the subsequent sale of that horse while on the sale grounds is encouraged provided all settlements are made directly to the sale cashier.

12 WARRANTIES

Warranties and limited warranties are as stated in the consignment contract and the Sale Terms posted in the sale catalog. IN THE EVENT YOUR HORSE POSSESSES ANY FAULT, DEFECTS OR CONDITIONS STATED, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO INFORM SALE MANAGEMENT IMMEDIATELY SO THAT PROPER ANNOUNCEMENTS MAY BE MADE. ANY VARIATION OF THIS POLICY ALLOWS BUYERS TO RETURN HORSE(S) WITH FULL REFUND. Owners are warned that any horse refused by the Buyer for lack of disclosure of any warranty or limited warranty described in the Sale Terms will be subject to return. Upon any such return, owner will owe the sale expenses and sale commission (8%) or \$1,000.00, whichever is greater.

13 RADIOGRAPH REPOSITORY

An online radiograph repository will be provided by Asteris Keystone for a fee of \$20/horse. It is available for the benefit of owners/buyers and participation is VOLUNTARY. Recommended and suggested views are included in this packet and provided on the Fall Sale page of our website – www.trihorse.com. If participating, owners may submit radiographs that are dated within 60 days before the first sale session and must be submitted no later than 12:00 pm CST on Sunday, October 13.

14 NO AUCTION ARENA GUESTS

Liability and strict auction policy allow no person(s) in the auction arena while a horse is selling except representative(s).

15 ANNOUNCEMENTS/OWNER PARTICIPATION

Owners are not allowed to personally use the auction PA system to comment as a horse is selling. Diligent attention and great expense have been made to secure extremely qualified announcers and auctioneers at the sale. If an owner has additional details to add in the sale of a horse, it may be done by submitting a written note for announcement or commenting clearly to the professionals on the auction block for announcement.

16 OWNERS RIGHT TO BID

This auction is conducted “with reserve”, meaning the right to bid is reserved by the owner. To protect the desired sale price for the horse, owner or its representative must:

- a. deliver a completed official reserve bid form to AuctionWare LLC, (either in the sale office or at the auction block with assistance of a designated sale staff member) within 30 minutes prior to the sale of the horse OR
- b. instruct AuctionWare LLC, or its designated sale staff member of the amount of the reserve bid OR
- c. be the final bidder and sign the Buyers Acknowledgement Of Purchase And Security Agreement OR
- d. make known to AuctionWare LLC, for announcement that the horse has been repurchased or passed-out BEFORE LEAVING THE AUCTION ARENA.

AuctionWare LLC reserves the right to bid on the behalf of the owner up to the amount of the reserve bid. If the owner or its representative makes a final bid equal to or greater than the reserve, owner will pay the 8% sale commission due.

17 UPSET BID

Unless waived by announcement, there shall be a minimum “upset (starting) bid” of \$1,000.00 for any horse presented for sale. If the “upset (starting) bid” is not received, the horse shall be automatically repurchased by the owner as unsold and all expenses become due by owner to sale management, thus no horse will be sold for less than \$1,000.00.

18 AQHA TRANSFERS

The AQHA transfer fee is the responsibility of the owner and will be deducted from your sale proceeds.

19 HALTERS

A complimentary shipping halter and lead will be provided for each horse sold. Buyers may pick up halters in the sale office after full account settlement has been made. DO NOT leave the auction arena with our leather show halter.

20 PHOTOS

- b. We cannot play YouTube video from a mobile phone.
- c. You may bring a Thumb Drive with the YouTube link of your sale entry to the sale. Please have the HORSE NAME AND HIP NUMBER clearly marked. We will assume the thumb drive takes priority over any other video previously submitted. Please make sure the video is at the point of play and that it works properly. TAKE THUMB DRIVES directly TO THE VIDEO STATION located behind the auction box.
- d. **TRIANGLE SALES STAFF MAKES ABSOLUTELY NO GUARANTEE THAT YOUR VIDEO WILL BE PLAYED AT THE TIME OF SALE.**

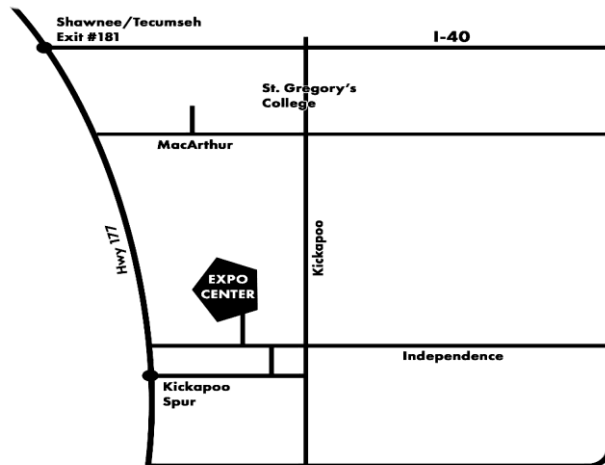
Take I-40 to Shawnee/Tecumseh Exit 181.

ORIGINAL COGGINS AND HEALTH CERTIFICATE

ORIGINAL COGGINS AND HEALTH CERTIFICATE

- 1) Horses may not be on the grounds **NOR PASS THROUGH THE SALE RING ARENA WITHOUT A CURRENT, ORIGINAL NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST ON FILE IN THE SALE OFFICE.**

It must be **DATED WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF THE SALE**, as required due to nationwide varying state health regulations.

COPIES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE NOR ARE TEST RESULTS PRINTED ON A HEALTH CERTIFICATE.

- 2) Failure to present a current, original negative Coggins test will result in the dismissal of the sale entry from the sale grounds and owner will owe the sale expenses and a \$2,000 withdrawal fee.
- 3) Original health certificate dated within twenty (20) days prior to the sale is required.

Incorrect Description on Coggins

Copy or Fax of Coggins

RADIOGRAPH REPOSITORY INFORMATION SHEET

Owners:

1. An online radiograph repository will be provided by Asteris Keystone for a fee of \$20/horse. It is available for the benefit of owners and buyers. Participation is VOLUNTARY.

2. Asteris, Inc. will provide veterinarians with an online application for remote radiograph submission. Please have your vet visit www.trihorse.com or contact Asteris, Inc. (877) 727-8374, Extension 402 for information and assistance with the link to the application that will allow the submission of images from his/her system.

If participating, owners may submit radiographs that are dated within 60 days before the first sale session and must submit no later than 12:00 pm CST on SUNDAY, OCTOBER 13.

Given that horses can and do injure themselves, images may be added to the repository for an "area of concern", if the original upload has already been accomplished. A corresponding report from the veterinarian is required and the images must be added during the regular submission date range.

Owners will be held responsible for associating radiographs with the horse(s). If the horse name is changed in the radiographs knowingly or unknowingly, or if the images have been tampered with, the owner is responsible for any charges incurred from a dispute.

Veterinarians:

The following views are recommended:

Both carpi: DLPMO, PLDMO (just off lateral), flexed lateral medial

Both hocks: Just off DP 10 degrees (slight DLPMO), lateral medial, PLDMO

Both stifles: Lateral medial (getting the proximal tibia as well as the trochlear ridges of the femur and patella) and a plantar anterior as long as the condyles are visible

The following views are suggested:

Both front fetlocks: DP, flexed lateral medial

Both hind fetlocks: DP, standing lateral medial

For horses 2 years and older it is also suggested to have:

the front feet radiographed 60 degree DP and Skyline

Please label the studies in this manner:

Patient = **Lot Number** as it is in the catalog AND **Horse Name** (AQHA Registered Name...NOT Barn Name) are required

Owner = **Consignor**, as listed in the catalog

Neither Asteris, Inc. nor the sales company will be screening images for positioning or technique; this is the responsibility of the veterinarian at the time of acquisition.
