STALLING

Bedded stalls will be available, at no additional fee, beginning Thursday, APRIL 29, at 8:00 am. Early arrivals should contact the sale office for arrangements. Additional bedding may be purchased through OK State Fair Park Feed and Bedding at 405-948-6786 OR YOU MAY BRING ADDITIONAL SHAVINGS. No straw or hay bedding is allowed by the Fairgrounds. Bring your buckets, feed and hay.

NO HORSES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SALE STALLS UNLESS ENTERED IN THE SALE.

Please have the HORSE NAME AND HIP NUMBER clearly marked on the thumb drive. Make sure the video is at the point of play and that it works properly. TAKE THE THUMB DRIVE directly TO THE VIDEO STATION located behind the auction box and give it to the Media Manager, J.R. Thornton.
- c. IF you have emailed a link and then decided to bring a Thumb Drive, please make it clear to J.R. that the thumb drive takes priority over any other video previously submitted and posted.
- d. **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE THE MEDIA MANAGER, J.R. THORNTON, HAS CLEAR INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING YOUR VIDEO. ADDITIONALLY, TECHNOLOGY ISSUES CAN AND WILL OCCUR...THE TRIANGLE SALES STAFF MAKES ABSOLUTELY NO GUARANTEE THAT YOUR VIDEO WILL BE PLAYED AT THE TIME OF SALE.**

The entire catalog is posted on our website at www.trianglehorsesales.net. You will also be mailed a catalog to the current address we have on file for you. PROMPTLY NOTIFY THE SALE OFFICE OF ANY CORRECTIONS PRIOR TO THE SALE. YOU ARE THE SOLE GUARANTOR OF ALL CATALOG INFORMATION.

ENGAGEMENTS/ELIGIBILITIES

Any special event eligibilities (not already listed in the sale catalog) should be indicated in writing at check-in for announcement during sale.

ORIGINAL REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS

Unless you have already forwarded these to the sale office, they are due **NOW**, and before your horse can sell.

- a. Original Registration Certificate
- b. Completed Transfer (authorized signatures must be on file at AQHA)
- c. Original Breeders Certificate (For Pregnant Broodmares/Embryos)

We will withhold any funds due until all such documents are delivered.

Additionally, you must notify us of any necessary changes to original registration certificates regarding color, markings, brands, sex, etc.

ORIGINAL NEGATIVE COGGINS & HEALTH CERTIFICATE – HORSES MAY NOT BE ON THE GROUNDS AND CANNOT GO THROUGH SALE RING WITHOUT THESE on file in the sale office

- a. Original Negative Coggins **DATED WITHIN ONE YEAR OF SALE**. COPIES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE NOR ARE TEST RESULTS PRINTED ON A HEALTH CERTIFICATE.
- b. Failure to present a current, original negative Coggins test will result in the dismissal of the sale entry from the sale grounds and owner will owe penalties.
- c. Original Health Certificate dated within twenty (20) days prior to the sale is required.

STATUS FOR PREGNANT MARES/RECIPIENTS

A veterinary certificate of “pregnancy” or “open” status, dated within twenty (20) days prior to the sale, must be submitted and on file in the sale office. The status may be noted on the Health Certificate or presented as an additional veterinary document.

CATTLE FEES ARE COMPLIMENTARY

A list of horses registered to use live cattle (cutting or roping) will be posted in the sale office. If you don't see your horse(s) on the list and you want to use live cattle, let us know immediately.

A custom track cow will be available in the sale ring for use during the sale at no charge.

An additional track cow will be available in the northeast corner of Barn 3 for practice at no charge.

FEES FOR ROPING STEERS AND CALVES ARE COMPLIMENTARY

During the preview, ropers must rope as close to catalog order as possible. Whether heading or heeling, a horse will be recognized from the Announcer 3 times for each end or a total of 6 times. After a horse has been recognized, its maximum of 6 times (3 on each end), it can only have another run if it is helping. Any horse not listed in the roping preview must rope last.

SALE DAY RESPONSIBILITY

It is your responsibility to get your horse to and from the auction arena. Handlers are available to lead your horse if needed.

PRIVATE SALES ON THE SALE GROUNDS – REFERRED TO AS “ALLEY SALES” - ARE NOT PERMITTED

No horse may be sold privately before it is offered publicly. If a horse is “repurchased” or “passed-out” in the auction arena, the subsequent sale of that horse while on the sale grounds is encouraged provided all settlements are made directly to the sale cashier.

WARRANTIES/48 HOUR GUARANTEE

Warranties and limited warranties are as stated in the consignment contract and the Sale Terms posted in the sale catalog. IN THE EVENT YOUR HORSE POSSESSES ANY FAULT, DEFECTS OR CONDITIONS STATED, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO INFORM SALE MANAGEMENT IMMEDIATELY SO THAT PROPER ANNOUNCEMENTS MAY BE MADE. ANY VARIATION OF THIS POLICY ALLOWS BUYERS TO RETURN HORSE(S) WITH FULL REFUND. Owners are warned that any horse refused by the Buyer for lack of disclosure of any warranty or limited warranty described in the Sale Terms will be subject to return. Upon any such return, owner will owe the sale expenses and sale commission (8%) or \$1,000.00, whichever is greater.

RADIOGRAPH REPOSITORY

An online radiograph repository will be provided by Asteris Keystone for a fee of \$25/horse. It is available for the benefit of owners/buyers and participation is VOLUNTARY. Recommended and suggested views are provided on the Spring Sale page of our website www.trianglehorsesales.net.

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Owners may submit radiographs that are dated within 60 days of the sale (Monday, February 26) and must be submitted no later than 5:00 pm CST, 2 days before the first sale session (Wed., April 27).

MANDATORY OFFICIAL VETERINARY WITHDRAWAL STATEMENT FOR MEDICALLY UNFIT OR DECEASED SALE HORSE

Seller's veterinarian must complete and submit the Triangle Sales Official Veterinary Withdrawal Statement found on the Forms page of our website – www.trianglehorsesales.net. Deceased sale horses will be excused with no charge if the seller's veterinarian completes and submits the Triangle Sales Official Veterinary Withdrawal Statement.

NO AUCTION ARENA GUESTS

Liability and strict auction policy allow no person(s) in the auction arena while a horse is selling except representative(s).

ANNOUNCEMENTS/OWNER PARTICIPATION

Owners are not allowed to personally use the auction PA system to comment as a horse is selling. Diligent attention and great expense have been made to secure extremely qualified announcers and auctioneers at the sale. If an owner has additional details to add in the sale of a horse, it may be done by submitting a written note for announcement or commenting clearly to the professionals on the auction block for announcement.

OWNERS RIGHT TO BID

This auction is conducted "with reserve", meaning the right to bid or repurchase is reserved by the owner. To protect the desired sale price for the horse, owner or its representative must:

- a. be the final bidder and sign the Buyers Acknowledgement Of Purchase and Security Agreement;
- b. deliver a completed official reserve bid form to Auctioneer (either in the sale office or at the auction block with assistance of a sale staff member) prior to the sale of the horse; OR
- c. instruct the Auctioneer or its designated representative of the amount of the reserve bid.

Owner must make known to the Auctioneer for announcement that the horse has been repurchased or passed-out BEFORE LEAVING THE AUCTION ARENA. Triangle Sales reserves the right to bid on the behalf of the owner up to the amount of the reserve bid.

UPSET BID

Unless waived by announcement, there will be a minimum "upset (starting) bid" of \$1,000.00, for any horse presented for sale. If the "upset (starting) bid" is not received, the horse will be automatically repurchased by the owner as unsold and all expenses become due by owner to sale management, thus no horse will be sold for less than \$1,000.00.

HALTERS

A complimentary shipping halter and lead will be provided for each horse sold. Buyers may pick up halters in the sale office after full account settlement has been made. DO NOT leave the auction arena with our leather show halter.

TRANSFERS

The transfer fee is the responsibility of the owner and will be deducted from sale proceeds.

DEDUCTIONS FOR PURCHASES

Sellers who are established customers may deduct any purchases from sale proceeds.

SALE RESULTS

Final sale prices of all entries, without buyer names, will be posted on the Triangle Sales website.

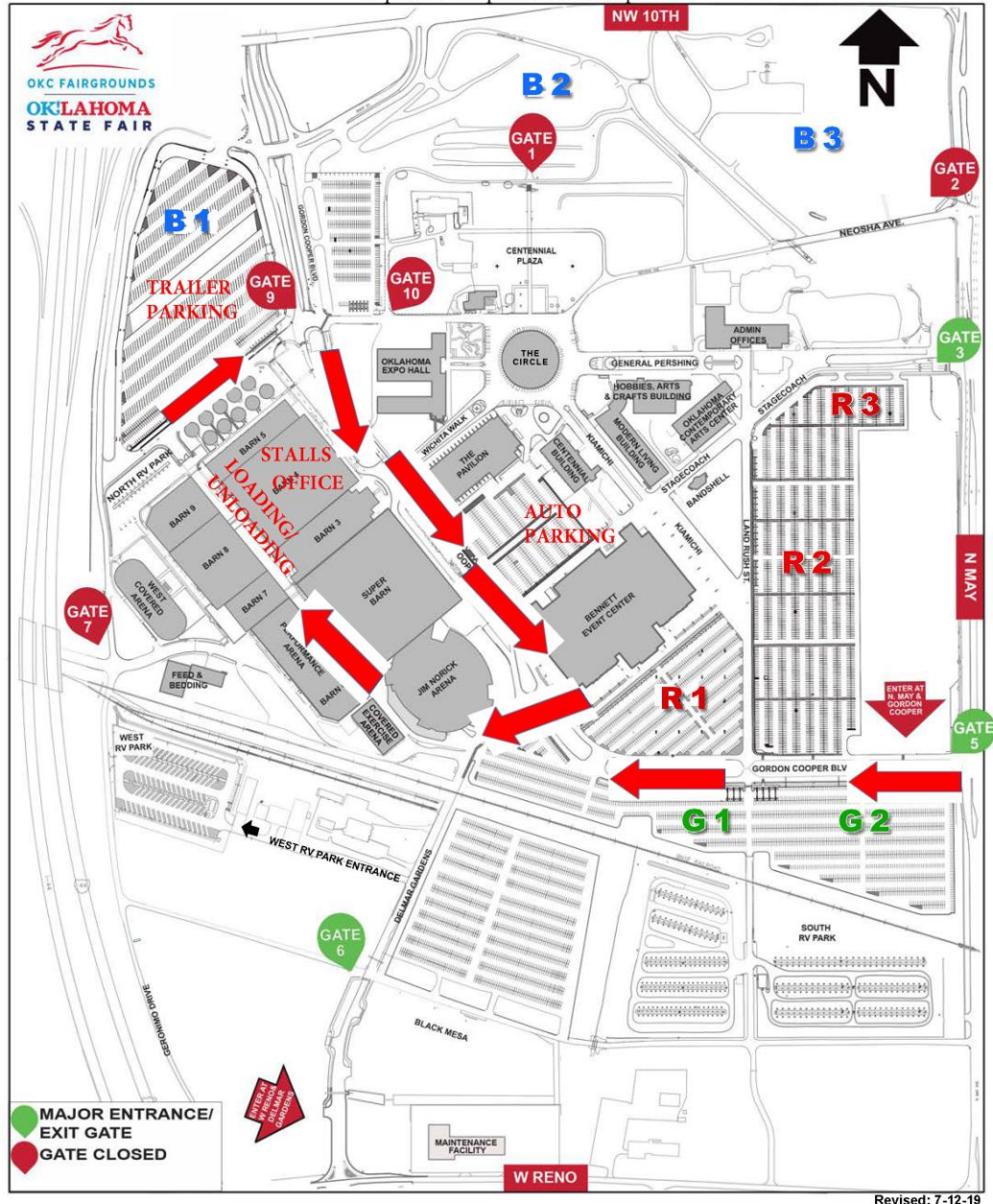
STATE FAIR PARK RV PARKS

Gate 5 (off May Ave) and Gate 6 (the light at Del Mar Gardens off Reno Ave) are the “main” gates.

- From I-40, going westbound: Exit Agnew/Villa/May Ave, turn north
- From I-40, going eastbound: Exit Portland Ave, turn north toward Reno Avenue, turn east on Reno OR Exit I-44 East, exit NW 10th St eastbound, stay on NW 10th To May Ave
- From I-44, going northbound: Exit I-44 East, exit NW 10th St eastbound, stay on NW 10th to May Ave
- From I-44, going west/southbound: Exit NW 10th St eastbound and proceed to May Ave
